BALSAM FIR

- ❑ The "traditional" Christmas tree
- ❑ Long tips allow ornaments to move
- ❑ Wonderful evergreen fragrance

FRASER FIR

- ❑ Very good needle retention
- ❑ Soft, elegant green and silver needles, easy to decorate
- ❑ Pleasing fragrance

CAANAN FIR

- ❑ Very good needle retention
- ❑ Similar in appearance to Balsam Fir, yet with darker green needles
- ❑ Wonderful evergreen fragrance

COLORADO BLUE SPRUCE

- ❑ Attractive bluish needles
- ❑ Uniform, pyramidal form
- ❑ Sturdy branches are easy to decorate

NOBLE FIR

- ❑ Excellent needle retention
- ❑ Soft blue needles, nicely tiered branches
- ❑ Moderate evergreen fragrance

SCOTCH PINE

- ❑ Good needle retention
- ❑ Popular for broad-based shape, lots of branches for ornaments
- ❑ Nice pine fragrance

WHITE PINE

- ❑ Good needle retention
- ❑ Beautiful, soft needles
- ❑ Delightful pine fragrance

CONCOLOR FIR

- ❑ Excellent needle retention
- ❑ Beautiful, gray-green soft needles
- ❑ Great citrus fragrance
